Admission and Registration Requirements

Öğrenciler programa, ÖSYM'nin her yıl düzenlediği üniversiteye giriş sınavları kapsamında Beslenme ve Diyetetik Bölümü için SAY puan türünden bir önceki yılın taban puanları esas alınarak tercih yapmak suretiyle kabul edilmektedir.

Admission and Registration Requirements

Students are admitted to the program through the national university entrance examinations organized annually by ÖSYM. Applicants are placed in the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics based on their preferences and the quantitative (SAY) score type, taking into account the previous year's base scores.

Graduation Requirements

Üniversitemiz Lisans ve Ön lisans Eğitim ve Öğretim ve Sınav Yönetmeliği'nin 40'ıncı maddesi uyarınca, ilgili öğrencinin, kayıtlı olduğu programın müfredatında yer alan tüm dersleri başarı ile tamamlaması, genel not ortalamasının 4,00 üzerinden en az 2,00 ve tamamladığı toplam kredinin en az 240 AKTS olması durumunda öğrenci, ilgili programdan lisans diploması almaya hak kazanır.

Graduation Requirements

In accordance with Article 40 of the University's Undergraduate and Associate Degree Education and Examination Regulations, a student becomes eligible to receive a bachelor's degree from the relevant program if they successfully complete all courses in the curriculum of the program in which they are enrolled, achieve a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 out of 4.00, and complete a minimum of 240 ECTS credits.

About the Program

Antalya Bilim Üniversitesi Sağlık Bilimleri Fakültesi Beslenme ve Diyetetik Bölümü Yüksek Öğretim Kurumu'nun 2457 sayılı Kanun'un 2880 sayılı değişiklik kararı ile kurulmuş olup 2021-2022 eğitim yılında lisans eğitimine başlamıştır. Antalya Bilim Üniversitesi Sağlık Bilimleri Fakültesi bünyesinde yer alan Beslenme ve Diyetetik Bölümü; 21. yüzyıl sağlık anlayışı çerçevesinde, uluslararası standartlarda, yaratıcılık ve bireysel gelişimi önemseyen, yaşam boyu öğrenme ve etik davranış, güvenli ve yetkin uygulama becerisine sahip, ülkemiz ve dünyadaki kültürlerle iletişime açık Diyetisyenler yetiştirmeyi hedeflemektedir. Eğitim dili Türkçe ve eğitim süresi 4 yıl olup ve bu Lisans programına sayısal (SAY) puan türüne göre öğrenci alınmaktadır. Beslenme ve Diyetetik bölümünden mezun olan diyetisyenler birçok alanda istihdam olanaklarına sahiptir. Bu alanlardan bazıları yataklı tedavi kurumları, renal bakım üniteleri, diyabet eğitim merkezleri, enteral-parenteral beslenme ekibi, özel beslenme ve diyet merkezleri, toplu beslenme sistemleri (kreşler, okullar, yemek fabrikaları, otellerin yiyecek içecek servisleri, toplu beslenme yapan tüm kurumlar vb.), gıda sanayisi, besin ve beslenmeyle ilgili özel veya kamu kuruluşları, ana çocuk sağlığı merkezleri, aile sağlığı merkezleri, yaşlı bakım merkezleri, spor merkezleri, eğitim ve araştırma kurumlarıdır. Beslenme ve Diyetetik Lisans Programından mezun olanlara "Diyetisyen" unvanı verilmektedir.

About the Program

The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics within the Faculty of Health Sciences at Antalya Bilim University was established by the decision of the Council of Higher Education in accordance with Law No. 2547 and the amendment introduced by Law No. 2880, and it started its undergraduate education in the 2021-2022 academic year. The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics, operating under the Faculty of Health Sciences at Antalya Bilim University, aims to educate dietitians who meet international standards within the framework of the 21st-century understanding of health; who value creativity and individual development; who adopt lifelong learning and ethical principles; who possess safe and competent professional practice skills; and who are open to communication with different cultures in Türkiye and around the world. The language of instruction is Turkish and the duration of the program is four years. Students are admitted to this undergraduate program based on the quantitative (SAY) score type. Graduates of the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics have employment opportunities in many fields. These include inpatient treatment institutions, renal care units, diabetes education centers, enteral and parenteral nutrition teams, private nutrition and diet counseling centers, mass catering systems (such as nurseries, schools, catering companies, hotel food and beverage services, and other institutions providing mass food services), the food industry, private or public institutions related to food and nutrition, maternal and child health centers, family health centers, elderly care centers, sports centers, and educational and research institutions. Graduates of the Nutrition and Dietetics Undergraduate Program are awarded the title of "Dietitian."

Exams, Assessment and Evaluation

Examinations at the University consist of midterm examinations, final examinations, make-up examinations, exemption examinations, additional examinations, and single-course examinations. Examinations are conducted according to the schedule prepared and announced by the Faculty. Students are required to present their student identification cards in order to take the examinations. There is no resit (make-up for final) examination system at the University; however, a summer school program is available. The midterm examination is conducted during the semester in which the course is offered in the undergraduate curriculum of the Faculty. At least one midterm examination is held for each course during a semester. Assignments, projects, or similar coursework conducted within the course may, at the discretion of the course instructor, be used in place of a midterm examination. The final examination is held at the end of the semester in which the course is offered, within the dates specified in the academic calendar. In order to be eligible to take the final examination, students must fulfill the requirement of at least 70% attendance in the course. The grade ranges used to determine whether students are considered successful in a course are as follows:

Program Educational Objectives

Beslenme ve diyetetik alanında bilimsel bilgi ve kanıta dayalı yaklaşımları kullanarak bireylerin ve toplumun beslenme durumunu değerlendirebilen, beslenme sorunlarına yönelik uygun müdahaleleri planlayıp uygulayabilen diyetisyenler yetiştirmek. Sağlığın korunması, geliştirilmesi ve hastalıkların önlenmesi veya tedavisinde beslenme tedavisini etkili biçimde planlayabilen, farklı yaşam dönemlerine ve hastalık durumlarına uygun beslenme programları oluşturabilen meslek profesyonelleri yetiştirmek. Beslenme bilimi, toplum beslenmesi ve toplu beslenme sistemleri alanlarında disiplinler arası ekiplerle çalışabilen, etik ilkelere bağlı, iletişim becerileri güçlü ve toplumsal sorumluluk bilincine sahip bireyler yetiştirmek. Bilimsel gelişmeleri takip eden, araştırma yapabilen, eleştirel ve analitik düşünme becerisine sahip, yaşam boyu öğrenmeyi benimseyen ve mesleki gelişimini sürdürebilen mezunlar yetiştirmek.

Program Educational Objectives

To educate dietitians who can assess the nutritional status of individuals and communities by using scientific knowledge and evidence-based approaches in nutrition and dietetics, and who can plan and implement appropriate interventions for nutrition-related problems. To train professionals who can effectively plan and implement nutrition therapy for the protection and promotion of health, as well as for the prevention and treatment of diseases, and who can develop appropriate nutrition programs for different life stages and disease conditions. To educate individuals who can work collaboratively in interdisciplinary teams in the fields of nutritional sciences, public health nutrition, and food service systems; who adhere to ethical principles; and who possess strong communication skills and social responsibility. To graduate professionals who follow scientific developments, are capable of conducting research, possess critical and analytical thinking skills, adopt lifelong learning, and continuously improve their professional competencies.

Recognition of Prior Learning

ÖSYM tarafından yapılan merkezî yerleştirme, başarı koşulu ile yurtiçi ve yurtdışı kurumlar arası yatay geçiş, merkezî yerleştirme puanı ile kurumlar arası ve kurum içi yatay geçiş ile fakültemize öğrenci kabul edilmektedir. Fakültemize kabul edilen öğrenciler, kayıt yaptırmadan önce kayıtlı oldukları lisans veya ön lisans programlarından başarılı oldukları derslerin fakültemiz ders müfredatına intibak ettirilmesini talep edebilirler. Bu talep, öğrencinin, öğrenim görmeye başlayacağı akademik yılın başında Fakülte Dekanlığı' na yazacağı bir dilekçe ile yapılır. Talepte bulunan öğrencinin, dilekçesine onaylı bir not döküm (transkript) belgesinin aslını eklemesi gereklidir. İntibak işlemi, Sağlık Bilimleri Fakültesi Yönetim Kurulunun ve görevlendireceği komisyonların belirlediği esaslar çerçevesinde gerçekleştirilir. İntibak işlemlerinde ders içerikleri ve AKTS yükü gözetilir.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Students are admitted to the Faculty through central placement conducted by ÖSYM, inter-institutional transfers between domestic and international higher education institutions based on academic achievement requirements, transfers based on central placement scores, and internal transfers within the institution. Students admitted to the Faculty may request the recognition and transfer of courses they have successfully completed in previously enrolled undergraduate or associate degree programs to the Faculty's curriculum before completing their registration. This request must be submitted through a petition addressed to the Dean's Office at the beginning of the academic year in which the student will commence their studies. The petition must be accompanied by the original approved transcript documenting the courses completed. The course transfer and adaptation process is carried out in accordance with the principles determined by the Faculty of Health Sciences Administrative Board and the commissions assigned by it. Course contents and ECTS workload are taken into consideration during the adaptation process.

Transition to Higher Degree Programs

Graduates of the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics may pursue postgraduate education after obtaining their bachelor's degree. In order to enroll in relevant postgraduate programs, they must meet the requirements determined by the respective institutes, including minimum grade point average, foreign language proficiency, ALES score, and other examination requirements.

Program Outcomes
