Graduation Requirements

Students in the Private Law Master's Program with Thesis are entitled to graduate provided that they complete at least eight courses in the curriculum, including the seminar course, with no fewer than 60 ECTS credits, successfully complete a total of 120 ECTS credits consisting of coursework and thesis study, and pass the thesis examination.

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About the Program

Özel Hukuk Tezli Yüksek Lisans Programı, özel hukukun temel alanlarında ileri düzey akademik bilgi ve araştırma becerisi kazandırmayı amaçlayan bir lisansüstü eğitim programıdır. Program kapsamında Medeni Hukuk, Borçlar Hukuku, İş ve Sosyal Güvenlik Hukuku, Milletlerarası Özel Hukuk, Ticaret Hukuku, Medeni Usul ve İcra İflas Hukuku gibi alanlarda teorik ve uygulamaya yönelik dersler sunulur. Öğrenciler, özel hukukun temel kavram ve kurumlarını derinlemesine inceleme, güncel hukuki sorunları analiz etme ve bilimsel araştırma yöntemlerini kullanarak akademik çalışmalar yürütme imkânı elde ederler. Programın tez aşamasında öğrenciler, belirledikleri bir konuda bilimsel araştırma yaparak akademik bir tez hazırlarlar. Programın amacı, özel hukuk alanında uzmanlaşmış, analitik düşünme ve bağımsız araştırma yetkinliğine sahip hukukçular yetiştirmektir.

About the Program

The Master's Program with Thesis in Private Law is a graduate education program that aims to provide advanced academic knowledge and research skills in the fundamental areas of private law. The program offers theoretical and practical courses in areas such as Civil Law, Law of Obligations, Labor and Social Security Law, International Private Law, Commercial Law, Civil Procedure, and Bankruptcy Law. Students have the opportunity to examine the fundamental concepts and institutions of private law in depth, analyze current legal issues, and conduct academic studies using scientific research methods. In the thesis phase of the program, students prepare an academic thesis by conducting scientific research on a topic they have chosen. The aim of the program is to train lawyers who are specialized in private law and possess analytical thinking and independent research skills.

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Program Educational Objectives

The Master's Program in Private Law with Thesis aims to provide students with advanced theoretical knowledge in the core disciplines of private law, to enable them to examine legal issues through scientific research methods, and to help them develop a level of specialization sufficient for academic work. The program seeks to offer in-depth knowledge in the principal fields of private law, including Civil Law, Labour and Social Security Law, Private International Law, Commercial Law, and Civil Procedure and Enforcement-Bankruptcy Law. One of the main objectives of the program is to ensure that students are able to comprehend both classical and contemporary debates in private law, improve their skills in interpreting and evaluating legal norms, and approach legal problems with an analytical, critical, and solution-oriented perspective. In this context, the program aims not only to provide students with knowledge of legislation, but also to enable them to make multidimensional assessments by taking into account judicial decisions, doctrinal views, and comparative legal data. As a thesis-based program, one of its primary goals is also to equip students with the ability to conduct independent research, access scientific resources, carry out studies in accordance with the rules of academic writing, and prepare an original thesis. The program aims to contribute to the training of legal professionals who are committed to the principles of academic ethics, capable of systematic thinking, able to formulate research questions, and able to express their findings in accordance with academic standards. In addition, the program seeks to strengthen the advanced legal analysis, interpretation, and evaluation skills that graduates will need both in academic settings and in professional fields such as the judiciary, public institutions, and other areas of legal practice. Accordingly, it is envisaged that students will be trained as competent individuals who can relate the theoretical foundation of private law to practice, follow national and international developments, and make scholarly contributions to the field of private law.

Transition to Higher Degree Programs

Upon earning the master's degree, graduates of the Master's Program in Private Law with Thesis may pursue further graduate studies, provided that they meet the admission requirements determined by the relevant institute for such programs, including the required grade point average, foreign language proficiency, ALES score, and other examination qualifications.

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Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning

The courses previously taken by the student at the institution where they were formerly enrolled are subject to transfer and recognition upon evaluation by the Head of the Department, following a comparison of their course contents with those of the courses offered in the curriculum of our University's Master's Program in Private Law with Thesis.
